Jonk Entrepreneuren Luxembourg makes the connection between school and the world of work by empowering young people to develop entrepreneurial knowledge and competencies.

The Company Programme ("mini- entreprises") gives students the opportunity to experience and to learn about entrepreneurship through a hands-on approach. Throughout one school year, students make all the decisions about their mini-company, from deciding on the name and product to creating a business plan, managing the mini-company's finances and selling to clients.

All this takes place with the support of a business volunteer who carries an extensive background of knowledge and expertise in the business field. The role of a volunteer is to inspire young people, to mentor and guide them in their project, to encourage them to overcome and learn from various challenges, to give them specific practical advice and support depending on the specific needs of each team. Coaches/mentors have regular meetings with their team and help students to understand how a company works by helping them prepare a presentation, improving their financial or marketing strategies or by putting them in contact with the corporate world.
